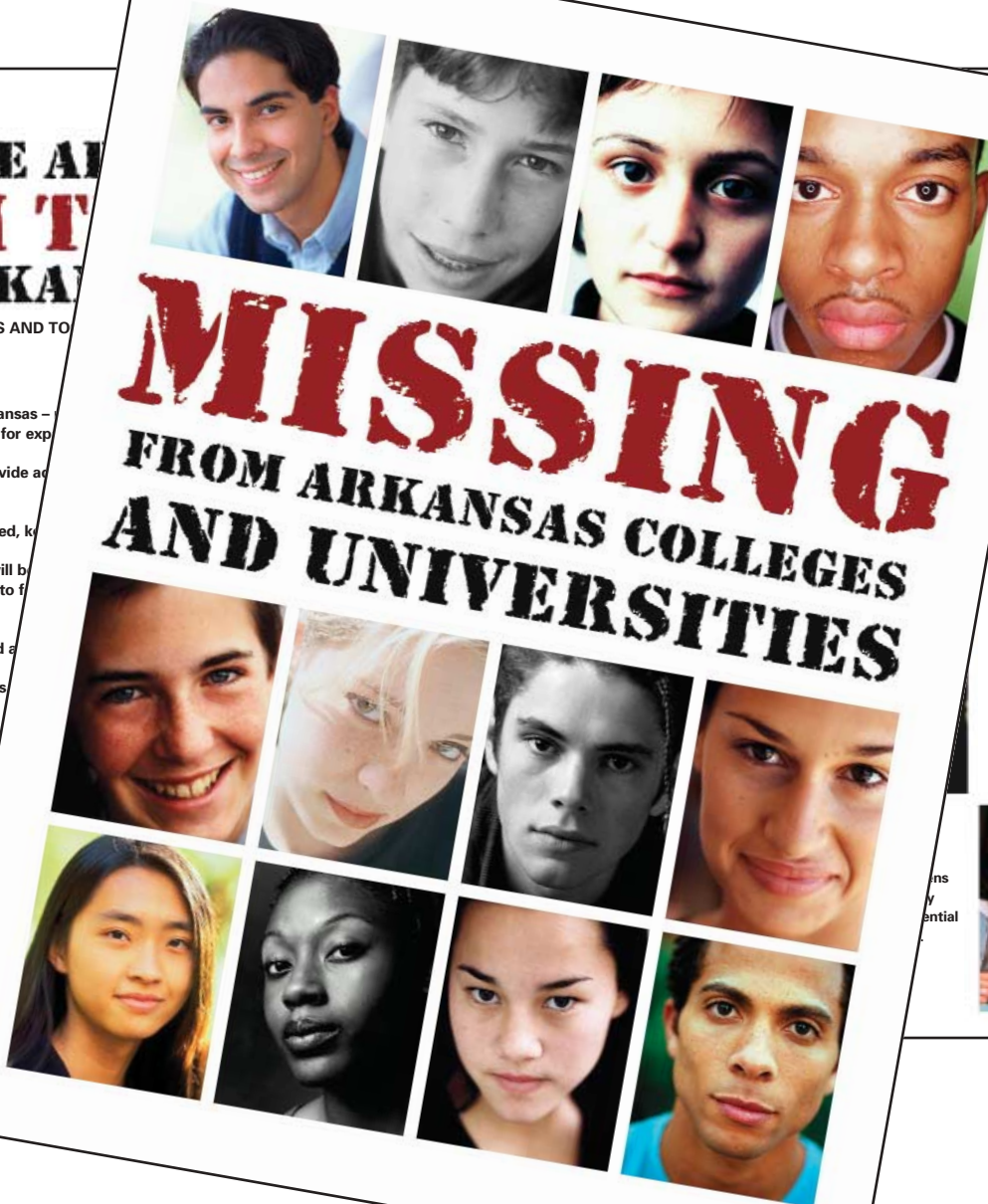
The colleges and universities of Arkansas – in an economic situation – are **not asking** for extra

- Critical maintenance on college facilities and costly deterioration will occur.
- Vital student services such as counseling and financial aid causing retention rates to drop.

The steady progress made by young Arkansans will be halted and a downward spiral in college enrollment rates will occur.
